

# RULES OF THE ROAD

- You may get off the bus at places other than bus stops only if the driver feels it is safe.
- Please have exact change – drivers do not make change.
- Please no eating or drinking on the bus with the exception of bus operators.
- No smoking of any kind on buses.
- Please do not litter on or off the bus. Many bus stop areas are on private property and could be removed.
- Be courteous. Seats in designated areas are reserved for senior citizens and riders with disabilities.
- Everyone must be behind the yellow line before the bus can leave its stop. No standing in front of line.
- Remain seated while vehicle is in motion, unless seats are not available.
- Please refrain from having distracting conversations with a TAWC Bus Operator.
- Please do not disturb or harass other passengers. Loud and disruptive riders will be asked to depart the bus.
- Please keep all electronic devices at a low volume as a courtesy to passengers and the driver. Playing music (except with earphones) is prohibited on TAWC vehicles.
- Conversations on cellular devices should not distract the driver or other passengers.
- Please refrain from cursing and using profanity.
- Shirts, pants and shoes are required at all times.
- Please do NOT take up more than one seat if the vehicle is crowded.
- Limit your carry-on packages to the equivalent of two paper grocery bags. If the bus is starting to fill up, please put your packages on your lap or on the floor in front of you. Do NOT take up a seat with your packages.
- Walkers and strollers MUST be folded. If you have a child in a stroller, please hold child in lap.
- No engaging in unauthorized canvassing, selling, soliciting or distributing any material on-board buses.
- All passengers on Authority vehicles shall maintain appropriate, reasonable personal hygiene. If riders have open or seeping sores or are leaking bodily fluids, for health and safety reason, Authority may refuse service until the situation has been contained or corrected. This also applies to hygiene that is so offensive as to constitute a nuisance to other passengers or drivers.
- All wheelchairs or mobility device must be secured while in an Authority's vehicle.
- No operating or tampering with equipment or tie-downs or other wheelchair restraints when on the vehicle.
- NO hazardous material of any kind.
